Planning for a Celebration of Life - Outline, Description, & Resource List

The outline below is based upon three main sources: the Book of Common Prayer (1979) and Enriching Our Worship 2 (2000) and 3 (2007). Combinations of these can also be used in concert with the flexible outline "An Order for Burial" in the Book of Common Prayer, p. 506. The links for these online sources are shared below this basic outline/structure, to help you choose from the several options. Biblical reading and hymn ideas are shared below that.

Basic Outline:

1. Service of the Word

Opening Anthem (spoken or sung poem) and/or an opening Hymn (Hymn ideas included at end of this guide)

(Book of Common Prayer (BCP), pp. 491-492 or Enriching Our Worship III (EOW), pp. 27-28)

Opening Prayers

(BCP pp. 493-494 or EOW pp. 29-31)

Readings – Most often there are three biblical readings, with one or two hymns/chants/instrumental music interspersed between. A list of reading ideas is included at the conclusion of this guide. Additionally

- A poem and/or favorite prose passage from another source can be one or more of the readings
- You can choose fewer readings than three
- If the service includes Communion, then the third passage should be from one of the Gospels
- If the family would like specific people to do the readings, please let us know and we will list them in the booklet

Homily and Eulogy/ies

- If the family would like someone specific to give the homily, please let us know
- In addition to a homily, a remembrance(s) / Eulogy(ies) can come during the service. If you would like that, please let us know who will give the eulogy so they can be properly listed in the booklet.
- If the family would like an open / unplanned time of sharing, that works best in the reception. We can set up a microphone for that if you'd like.

The Apostle's Creed (*BCP* p. 486) can follow the Homily and Eulogies – please let us know either way

Prayers of the People (+ The Lord's Prayer just prior, if service does not include Communion) (options at *BCP* p. 497 or *EOW* pp. 79-83)

- If there is a specific person the family would like to have lead the Prayers of the People, please let us know and we will list them in the booklet

Commendation if the service does not include Communion, then there is a prayer of Commendation at this point. If there is Communion, the Commendation comes at the end of the service. (*BCP* 499-500 or *EOW* 35-37)

2. Service of the Table / Communion

A Hymn, chant, or instrumental music can precede the Eucharistic Prayer

There are various Eucharistic Prayer options if you would like to choose (*BCP* pp. 361-363; 367-369; 370-372; 373-376; or *EOW I*. pp. 57-65)

A hymn, chant, or instrumental music can be shared during Communion

3. Commendation

The Celebrant stands before the casket or urn and leads prayers, commending to God the person who has died (*BCP* pp. 499-500 or *EOW* 35-37)

If no remains are present, then we bring the service to a close with final prayers (*EOW* pp. 70-78, or from other sources)

Celebrant offers a final blessing

Concluding hymn, chant, or instrumental music, if desired

4. Burial / Scattering of Ashes

- There is a separate, brief service that can take place at the graveside or the scattering of ashes (the Committal, *BCP* pp. 501-502 or *EOW* pp. 59-69). This can happen (and often does happen) at a later date.
